Coalition For Religious Freedom's campaign against CAN

This summer the Coalition for Religious Freedom did a mailing to all congressmen claiming CAN had some responsibility in the child abuse death of Lisa Steinberg in New York in 1987. This is a follow-up mailing to a letter sent this past April alleging the same thing.

Enclosed is a copy of the letter all congressmen received from the Coalition as well as a copy of CAN's reply to all congressmen.

CAN encourages its members to write their own congressmen to let them know how helpful CAN has been to you. Urge them not to be influenced by the false information in this letter and point out that the Unification Church of Sun Hung Moon, one of the wealthiest destructive cults in America, funds the Coalition for Religious Freedom. Stress CAN's value as a non-profit educational organization.

FBI investigation of Scientology and Alamo Foundation

CAN has received notification from the Internal Revenue Service that investigations are underway on both the Alamo Christian Foundation and the Church of Scientology.

Concerning the Alamo Foundation, the IRS is especially seeking information from people who may have worked for Alamo-related businesses.

Concerning Scientology, the IRS is especially interested in information on Sterling Management Consultants, Applied Scholastics, Singer Consultants or other businesses which may have links to Scientology.

CAN extends deepest sympathy to Gabe Cazares at the death of his wife Maggie, on August 24, following a long illness.

Maggie, with her husband Gabe, had filed a \$1.5 million lawsuit against the Church of Scientology when Gabe was mayor of Clearwater, claiming Scientologists were invading their privacy and maliciously prosecuting them with a frivolous lawsuit. The Cazareses' suit was settled out of court in 1986 but, without their knowledge, the court records were sealed. They have been fighting to have their case made public record.
