

# DIANETICS AND SCIENTOLOGY

The way goes up through health and happiness, through many releases and cognitions about the nature of life to the state of a free and powerful immortal being.

The way is there for each and everyone on this planet who can reach for it.

Each of us on this planet carries with him an enduring and deep desire for fulfilment. Here is the road to fulfilment, for you, for me, and for the entire planet.

The workings of the mind and the application of this knowledge to psychosomatic healing are contained complete in the Standard Dianetics Course, the first main course in the syllabus of Scientology education and training. On the course is the theory and application of Dianetics, the student both learns how to audit and receives auditing, as well as gaining a tremendous understanding and experience of the nature and the working of that part of the mind that causes human alienation.

## Barbarisms

Here is the core of a new Social Science, here is the means to build a civilisation out of all the barbarisms of this planet, not by political overthrow, but through a practical understanding of how man works, and the application of that knowledge to the expansion of the being to levels way beyond the dreams of all that came before. And if you want to know where to start, start with the Modern Science of Mental Health, the first published book in Dianetics, and still the best way in to all the knowledge that lies in wait for all those hoping and reaching for happiness and the creation of a new civilisation of freedom across the breadth of this planet.

Maybe it sounds fantastic. It is! My own searching has led me across much of this planet, through cultures ranging from the U.S. to Castro's Cuba, through ways of thinking from higher mathematics, through current Social Science and philosophy to the plays of Jean-Paul Sartre and the poems of Ginsberg et al. I have been through actions from the planting of Cuban coffee to playing the music about the insanities of the war in Vietnam, from the hunger of the Andean peasant to the joys of tripping high on L.S.D., yet nowhere have I found the hope and joy of beingness that I have begun to taste as I have started on this

road mapped out of this crazy maze to the realms of total freedom; this road which is the study and auditing of Dianetics and Scientology.

I have not yet gone very far, but I have gone far enough to really know where it is at and how much more there is to learn, and far enough to supervise the Standard Dianetics Course here in Southampton for all of you who want to study it.

This course is a core to Science in the humanities and Social Science. There is much more to it than just the skill of how to perform what looks like miracles.

Books and articles (which are on sale in the Union several lunchtimes during the week) contain knowledge applicable to several different fields, for these subjects of Dianetics and Scientology are all embracing. The goals and purposes of these subjects include many of those goals of different subjects which until now may have seemed to differ very much from one another. Here is material of relevance to all these areas: Psychology, Sociology, Philosophy, Theology, History, Politics, Law, Criminology, Organisation and Management and not the least "gung-ho" policy, which is a way to pull together and revitalise the purposes of all the different parts of a community, to create vitality and participation within it and, generally, to make it a better place to live in. (Gung-ho means pull together in mandarin chinese).

This knowledge has a right to be here at the University and students have a right to have it available for their studies. For here is the very knowledge that has been sought by countless men whom we study here today.

## Social Science Syllabus

I propose to the Social Science Faculty that the Dianetics Course becomes part of the Social Science syllabus, probably one of the second year optional subjects, and besides that I strongly recommend, that anybody and everybody reads the Modern Science of Mental Health.

# CULTURAL LAG

The reason why Dianetics and Scientology were abused or even fought has to do with what is called a "cultural lag."

This has often occurred in the history of technical developments.

An example is Dr. Semmelweis's discovery of the cause and cure of childbed fever. For over half a century after that women still died in agony after childbearing. Eventually the culture caught up to it and the illness which had accounted for a huge percentage of female deaths ceased to exist. Dr. Semmelweis's discovery of its prevention was "ahead of its time." Pathetically, scoffed and disbelieved, he even died to prove he was right.

The atomic bomb was wholly feasible more than a decade before it was "develped." No one credited it and no one put up the cash.

The radio telephone was invented and demonstrated half a century before it was generally used.

Cultural lag occurs for many reasons.

In any field as retarded as the human sciences the emergence of Dianetics and Scientology, full and workable and

complete is startling. And thereby subject to disbelief.

This does not mean they aren't used and useful.

It is significant that hundreds of aerospace technicians, working with satellites and rocketry broadly used Scientology first. At the same time parliaments in some socially backward countries were busy passing laws against Scientology to protect their psychiatrists whose medieval approach was to seize people without any process of law and castrate them and saw out brains as a "cure" for mental illness.

In a world where governments are fighting to dominate men's minds, mental technology is needed to protect the individual and to prevent the enslavement of all.

So Dianetics and Scientology may be a century ahead of their times but still they are just in time before we all go up in smoke.

Dianetics was the first practical workable easily taught science of the mind. It has endured already 19 years and is better and more used than ever before.

# SOME TIPS ON STUDYING

(Applicable to any study)

To achieve successful study there has to be:

- a) Something there to study.
- b) The idea that one does not know it all already.

In Dianetics the student studies the mind, the effect of the mind on the body, and how erasure of painful mental image pictures can relieve the body of psychosomatics.

In Scientology, the student studies Man's relationship to the Universe, who he is, what he is doing and the laws of life.

So there is plenty to study, and it is quite obvious that one does not know it all already. To say "well, I must know all about life because I'm living," doesn't explain irrational behaviour, unhappiness, loneliness, drug experiences or suffering. Any problem stems from people not knowing. If a person knew all about

life, he would have no problems in living.

The only reason a person gives up a study or becomes confused or unable to learn is because he has gone on past a word that was not understood. The confusion, or inability to learn, or the loss of interest stems from the student reading on past a word that he did not fully understand. This puts a 'block' on his understanding, and he reads on becoming more and more confused and rapidly losing his interest.

The solution is to recognise this, look over your materials, find out where you lost interest, get the misunderstood word, look it up in the dictionary, define and understand it, and you freshen up immediately with renewed interest and purpose, and can then continue with the syllabus.

Dianetics (Dia - through, noos - mind) has been 39 years in development.

It is the first fully precision science of the mind.

Physical illness, aches, pains, continual exhaustion, body malfunctions are created or held in an unchanging state by the mind. This is called **psychosomatic** (psycho-spirit, somatic-body) illness. It has been known about for a century but there has never been a positive remedy before Dianetics.

Auditing (it means to listen) is a term given to the application of Dianetics.

No drugs, no hypnotism, no mechanical treatment is used.

The actual source of psychosomatic illness has been isolated in Dianetics.

Processing is the action of letting the preclear (person not yet clear) find the actual source of his physical illness.

Processing requires usually 25 hours or less.

Various forms of mental therapy were in existence before Dianetics. These were psychology, psychiatry and psychoanalysis.

Psychology and psychiatry were developed chiefly by a Russian veterinarian named Ivan Petrovich Pavlov (1849-1936). His basic principle was that men were only animals and could be conditioned and trained much like dancing bears or dogs. This work was only intended to CONTROL people and so has found great favour with certain rulers and upper classes. None of the activities of psychology or psychiatry were designed to help or cure, only to control the masses.

Psycho-analysis was developed by an Austrian Jew, Sigmund Freud (1856-1939). His occasional successes served to point out there was a possibility of solving psychosomatic illnesses through addressing the mind. His concentration on sex gave the subject considerable popularity.

Dianetics was first released in 1950 and has been increasingly successful since that time. Unlike earlier studies, the interest of Dianetics was the relief of physical suffering.

The results of psychiatry are physically damaging, consisting of various brutalities and often injure the patient for life or kill him outright. There have never been any cures listed or claimed for psychiatric treatment as its interest lies only in control. The cost is about \$200.00 a month often for years in America and £60 a week for as long as a decade in England.

Psychology is mainly used for testing aptitude or intelligence. It has counselling as part of its activities but it is more concerned with and financed for warfare.

These two subjects have bitterly contested any healing subjects and used public media governments and even rumour to forward population control. This action has often made it difficult to bring about bona fide mental health to the people.

Psychoanalysis requires up to 5 years for an uncertain result and costs about £9,000.

Dianetics requires only a matter of hours, only helps and does not physically injure anyone.

It costs about 25 dollars an hour in the U.S. and about £50 total processing cost in the U.K.

There is no quarrel between Dianetics and general practitioners of the medical profession. They both have the same purpose (to make people well) and are not political. It is freely admitted in Dianetics that physical illness that can be effectively treated medically should be so treated. Auditing will not set a broken nose or deliver a baby. But it can help get the leg healed in two weeks instead of the usual six and after effects of child-birth do not exist when Dianetic auditing is also used.

Many people who cannot work, who cannot enjoy life, are physically ill without realising it.

Aches, pains, colds, even malfunctions of the body are symptoms of illness.

Remember 1950? Truman was president, the North Koreans invaded the tiny Republic of South Korea, and ladies skirts were a fashionable ten inches below the knee.

In 1950 too, a book hit the bookshops — soared to the top of the best seller lists and stayed there. The book? *Dianetics — The Modern Science of Mental Health*, created a trend and almost a fad. Luminaries of the day hailed the book with its promise of freedom from the problems and crises that beset the human mind as the greatest advance in human study since Freud. Walter Winchell was quoted as saying that "*Dianetics is a milestone for man comparable to his discovery of fire, and superior to his inventions of the wheel and arch.*"

As is common with any sudden success, the "anti-group" vociferous and authoritarian proceeded into the picture and much of the subject matter became clouded by opinion and cabal. Dianetics however continued, here, in Europe and in other countries. It grew up, it expanded and is now an established subculture in today's society.

Known now as Scientology — the overall philosophy of which Dianetics is a small part — this philosophy and — in its original sense, religious epistemology stands firm in every continent, and the United States has offices in every state in the Union.

Locally, the Orange County center, with headquarters in Tustin, attracts over 100 people weekly, and provides full services to its membership.

People from all walks of life attend. I have talked to a Catholic priest, one of the two who have taken courses in Scientology, to better their ability to serve their flock. A local D.C. states that through his studies and application of the techniques, he can now handle the problems of his practice and his life

smoothly and effortlessly — his practice has grown and he himself is a changed being.

A young mother recounts how she now handles her children with understanding and firm control, yet never losing patience. A business man in charge of a sales organization points with pride at the graphs of his results — slumps have gone — personnel are producing more rapidly and more qualitatively with less waste. "I can now proceed and handle the posts of three men without loss in efficiency," he stated.

An anesthesiologist commented: "What you actually do, while not interfering in the field of medicine, makes much of the theory of medicine seem like something out of the dark ages."

A professional engineer, a school teacher, a college student all came up with basically the same statement "Scientology works — it enables me to increase my own ability and brings about a greater sense of freedom and responsibility."

Show business people too have gone into Scientology and increased their capacity — I found that two stars of this season's T.V. programing both were undergoing counseling and study, but unlike the Maharishi fad Scientology is somewhat loath to reveal these names as it could be taken as a "band wagon" parade.

I also found a couple of critics of Scientology too, but on investigation I discovered that one person had never had any personal contact — and the other had been asked to leave because they would not disconnect from drugs.

I also heard some wild rumors — they got wilder the further out from actual Scientology activity I went.

A "member of Military Intelligence" reported that the founder L. Ron Hubbard was anchored three miles off the California shores and was refused entry — potently untrue since he is an American citizen and is currently in European waters doing some oceanographic research.

There is also a rumor that "All American Scientologists have been thrown out of England." It turns out that an advanced school was opened in Edinburgh and many of the students who were in England went North — to Scotland.

Last week, I was at the Orange County Center. I saw for myself a group of people — enthusiastic — cheerful and sharing a greater understanding of life than I have seen in other groups.

What happened to Dianetics? — it grew up!

### DIANETICS The Modern Science of Mental Health by L. Ron Hubbard Price \$1.25

A hefty volume for a paperback with a vivid purple exploding volcano, announcing the release, for the first time in paperback, of a book which has sold over a million copies in hard covers. The forward by J. A. Winter, M.D., states that "Dianetics will help a person eliminate psychosomatic illnesses and achieve at least one third more than the present capacity for work and happiness." And after reading the book, I must confess that if only half of what the book states is true this would be a vast understatement.

Dianetics, from the Greek: di-anoetikos; meaning 'through mind' is in fact a handbook containing all of the data necessary for the handling of interpersonal relations and the understanding of the mind. It takes the subject of the common man's everyday thoughts, anxieties and fears and leads him down through the hitherto impregnable fortress of the subconscious, only to discover that the demons which we fear are actually, simply, half seen and unseen memory recordings dating back even to the embryo period.

This prenatal memory, of course was frequently mentioned by Freud and others, but the Dianetic investigation goes further and discovers the prenatal 'engram'. An engram being 'a moment of pain and unconsciousness.'

The book written in a forth right style is both compelling and powerful. And I would strongly advise the reader to go several times over the preamble titled: "How to read this book."

Hubbard describes *Dianetics* as 'a voyage into Terra Incognita.' And certainly a person attempting to read this book without being willing to evaluate and if necessary, change certain fixed opinions about himself and his fellow would experience difficulty. But if the book is read to gain further enlightenment it becomes increasingly clear that a lot of man's physical and social ills are explained in this one small volume.

So we're left with the single question, "Has someone really figured us all out?" According to *Dianetics*, Modern Science of Mental Health, it would seem so.
